



2017-2018 Identity and Statement of Educational Purpose Form

As per federal regulation, Centenary must receive documentation of your identity AND a signed Statement of Educational purpose for the 2017-2018 award year.

You must come to the Centenary University’s Financial Aid Office **in person** to show your original government-issued ID for us to copy **and while in person** at our office, sign the Certification and Signature section below. If you are unable to provide the aforementioned documentation **in person**, then you must use the *Identity and Statement of Educational Purpose with Notarization Form*.

Identity and Statement of Educational Purpose (To Be Signed at Centenary University)

The student must appear in person at Centenary University to verify his or her identity by presenting an unexpired government-issued photo identification (ID), such as, but not limited to, a driver’s license, other state-issued ID, or passport. Centenary will maintain a copy of the student’s photo ID that is annotated with the date it was received and the name of the official at the institution authorized to collect the student’s ID.

In addition, the student must sign, in the presence of the Centenary official, the following:
